Missionaries of the Week: Vlad & Julia Kuzmich serving in Ukraine with EFCCM.

Dear church,

We are very thankful to God that you are praying and supporting us.

Here is update of our ministry and what God has done during several months.

In the end of September we had Exchanged life seminar again. There were 12-14 people from our church and other churches. After that we have started bible study as continuation of this seminar. We are planning to do follow up of this seminar this year starting from January 19th. It is helpful material that help to solve inner problems of Christians and get better relations with people. Pray with us that God will bring people whom it is necessary.

On 15th of October our church celebrated 15th anniversary. It was good to see how God worked in the lives of our people from our church during these years.

As usually we have Sunday service and during sermon time we have 4 Sunday school classes for children of different ages. It is blessing for parents, but also we have a need in teachers. Pray with us that Lord will bring more people in this ministry.

We have started new bible study group from fall. It is in downtown. There are about 7-10 young people are visiting from our church and other churches too. We would like to have at least one more bible study group. Continue to pray wit us about this.

Youth group is growing. We have several non-Christians who are visiting constantly.

Also several young people have started to visit our youth group from other church (Morning star church). It encourage our youth to be more open in caring for others.

Also several ladies are continuing to serve to orphans in Nikopol. Some of the orphans were adopted by Christian families from America.

As church we are serving with cloths. People are brining cloths to one lady who take it to the needy and refuge center in downtown to help refugees from East of Ukraine.

In our city we have R500 committee of Dnipro churches. They decided to prepare gifts on Christmas season to children who lost they fathers in war in the East of Ukraine (Donbass). Our church decided that we will participate too and we made several gifts and gave them to committee on 25th of December.

On 24th of December we had candlelight service. There were many people.

We would be appreciate if you will pray for us that God will direct our church in out-reach. Pray that Lord will give ideas how reach those with whom our Christians have contacts (community, relatives, neighbors, coworkers and others).

As for my family, in the middle of October my son David broke his right arm. It took for him 1.5 months to get it better. It was emotionally difficult for us when it happened and it was first time. There was anesthetic operation in order to fix his arm. Praise the Lord that David is better. Soon we would like to check his arm again at doctor to find out if he can visit swimming pool. Other children are doing good. Julia is doing good too and she continues to service as teacher in Sunday school for children.

Thank you again for your love and care for us.

We are praying for you too.
